RULES OF ENGAGEMENT**Order Process**

Since our entire collection of dresses is made to order, we do not place the order until we receive a completed order form from each member of the bridal party. The order form must be completely filled out, including payment information and signed "rules of engagement" in order to be considered complete. Each bride/bridesmaid is responsible for confirming designer, style and color before placing order and takes full responsibility for verifying all details listed with the customer look book provided by ...and something blue. Once order is placed with ...and something blue, your order may not be changed in any way. ...and something blue is not responsible for dresses that have left the store and have been in the customers' possession. There are no returns or exchanges. All sales are final!

At a minimum, production of dresses takes from 12-14 weeks from the date the final order is placed. Exact ship dates are not guaranteed, sometimes depending on a certain vendors production schedules dresses may run late. This 12-14 week window does not include shipping times. Please allow an additional 5-7 business days for in state shipping and 10-15 days for out-of-state shipping. Standard shipments are sent via UPS or FedEx ground, signature required. Delivery charges are additional and not included in the price of the dress. Customer is responsible for all shipping charges. There will be an automatic charge of \$25 for any returned or rerouted packages.

If your wedding requires less than 14 weeks for delivery, depending on the designer, these orders may be accommodated for an additional fee, however ...and something blue is not responsible for guaranteeing ship dates that fall within two weeks of the wear date. Rush fees do not include expedited shipping charges.

Sizes

All dresses are made to order, but not custom made to measurements. Alterations are often necessary and not included in the price of the dress. Any alterations needed are the responsibility of the customer and not the responsibility of ...and something blue. We are more than happy to assist with measurements, but do not take responsibility for final size or length decisions. All dresses are made to standard sizes and ordered by size only, measurements are only used as a guide for choosing a size from the designers size chart. As a rule it is easier to take in than let out a dress, so if your measurements fall between standard sizes, we recommend sizing up. This way you can have your cake and eat it too!

Fabrics

Several of our designers use various forms of natural silk. Silk fabrics may obtain occasional fabric textures and gentle shading variances, which are characteristic of fine silk yarn. These characteristics enhance the natural beauty of the fabrics and in no way should be treated as defects. Please be advised that the color of the finished garment may differ slightly from the swatch due to different dye lots. Dye lots may also differ when ordering different dress styles in the same color fabric, everything will be done to ensure that the dresses are made with the same dye lot of fabric, but cannot be guaranteed.

Style

From time to time, slight changes are made to the dress style, which may not be reflected in photographs on the website or in the dress sample at the store. Changes may include but are not limited to placement of boning, length of skirt, style, placement of straps, or the presence or absence of a strap. These changes are usually made to improve the fit or look of a dress and are at the discretion of the designer.
